Wisdom about Riches (James 1:9-11)

- 1. Being humble provides more wealth than anything we can muster.
 - a. Humility is not just an inner disposition. It also concerns one's status in the world.
 - b. But it also includes one's inner disposition. One can be arrogant with no money.
 - c. Boasting here should be understood as a declaration of God's righteousness.
- 2. When one is humble, it provides space for God to do the exaltation.
 - a. God does not like prideful people.
 - b. God wants to place his mark on those who belong to him. They must leave space for God to do his work.
- 3. The more money someone has, the more potential for problems.
 - a. Some problems come from people.
 - i. Jealousy
 - ii. Competition
 - iii. Violence
- 4. Most problems with money can be self-inflicted.
 - i. Idolatry
 - ii. Pride
 - iii. Greed
- 5. Having great wealth and substance demands intentional efforts to be humble.
 - a. Humble people try not to arrogantly flaunt what they have.
 - b. Humble people surrender everything they have to God.
